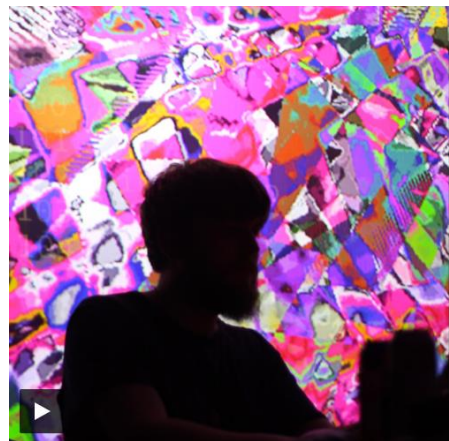

I am a freelance digital artist, live coding musician and PhD student, over the past five years I have worked with multiple organisations and collaborators, delivering teaching, making installations, creating performances and artworks and written code in nightclubs.
